If the answer to these questions is "yes," attend the meeting. Rich Baier, Alexandria's Director of Transportation and Environmental Services, will be there to answer your questions and to let us know:

- How the City will address the issue of traffic and parking due to new developments and
- What the City is doing to mitigate the adverse effects of the pollution from the Mirant Power Plant.

Traffic Light Scheduled by McDonald's (US1 and First Street)

The traffic light that NECA and its members have been asking for has been approved. This is part of the 1996 NECA Transportation Management Plan and has been brought up at meetings every since.

The Department of Transportation and Environmental Services (T&ES) submitted a request for this light to the Traffic and Parking Board. Some NECA members spoke at the hearing and it passed the Board. The next step was a vote by the City Council

at their Tuesday Legislative session. NECA is pleased that the measure passed without any objections.

Rich Bair, Director of T&ES, advises that it will take at least six months for the light to be installed.

Who Speaks for NECA - While we encourage all members to express their opinion at a public forum, only the President speaks on behalf of NECA.
