City Manager to Discuss City Budget

The City is in the process of preparing its budget for the next fiscal year and needs to consider the economic situation facing many cities while doing this.

Jim Hartmann, Alexandria City Manager, is coming to our association meeting to tell us how this economic situation will impact the city and what steps the city may be taking to address it.

This will give you an opportunity to give suggestions on the budget or express any concerns you may have on any potential or proposed cuts in city programs or services.

The Alexandria Democratic and Republican parties have agreed to five debates between the candidates for city council. There will be one in each of the three sections of the city: Eastern (which includes NorthEast), central, and western, which will focus on issues of interest to that section of the city and two exclusively on special interests.
