Due to increasing real estate costs and regional development pressures over the past decade, Alexandria faces a shortage of affordable housing, which is making it difficult for City and school employees, as well as other members of the workforce to live in Alexandria.

To address this, the City is undertaking a Citywide Housing Master Plan to establish a vision to guide future development with the goals of preserving and enhancing affordable housing and community diversity.

There will be citywide public community meetings on this issue over the next several months.

Eric Keeler, Division Chief of Administration (Housing) will be at our meeting to give details about this master plan, tell how you can participate in the process and answer your questions.

- Both sides of the alley on the east side of the 1400 block of Michigan Avenue from 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM on Mondays
- Change current parking restrictions on Mondays to 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM on both sides of the alley on the west side of the 1400 block of Michigan Avenue
