Special Association Meeting for Neighbors Who May Be Affected By New "No Parking" Restrictions on Michigan Avenue

Special Meeting

At the May 19th Association meeting concerns were raised because many of the neighbors on the streets adjoining Michigan Avenue did not know about the proposed "No Parking" restrictions on Michigan Avenue (see right hand column) until they received the Association's May meeting announcement, even though the City said they had informed the residents who may be affected.

A request was made by neighbors who live on the adjoining streets that the Association ask the City to defer the May 24 meeting of the Traffic and Parking Board until June and hold a meeting for those who may be adversely affected by these "No Parking" restrictions.

At the request of our Association the City agreed to postpone the public hearing until Monday, June 28.

This special Association meeting is for the residents of Michigan Avenue, its intersecting streets and NECA's board to discuss any problems the "No Parking" restrictions could cause and to decide the position the Association should take at the June 28 Traffic and Parking Board public hearing.

An invitation has been extended to waste management (who requested these restrictions) to send a representative to the meeting, but at the time of the printing of this flyer there has been no response to this invitation.

The May 24th Public Hearing was cancelled and rescheduled for Monday, June 28, 2010

(New "No Parking" Restrictions for Michigan Avenue)

On Monday, June 28, the Traffic and Parking Board will be holding a public hearing on the posting of "no parking" restrictions to facilitate refuse collection at the following:

- In front of 1314 and 1320 Michigan Avenue from 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM on Mondays
- Both sides of the alley on the east side of the 1400 block of Michigan Avenue from 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM on Mondays
- Change current parking restrictions on Mondays to 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM on both sides of the alley on the west side of the 1400 block of Michigan Avenue
