The City of Alexandria strongly objects to the Department of Corrections proposed location of the Alexandria Probation and Parole Offices in rental space at 1333 Powhatan Street. This area of the City, known as our Northeast neighborhood, is a densely populated residential area and includes many families with small children. It is the wrong location for a probation and parole office, and we urge you to find another site in Alexandria for this office.

I understand that our General Services Department has been asked to assist you in finding suitable space for the probation and parole offices, and they will continue to work with you. The City cannot accept the Powhatan Street location for these state offices, and we ask that you remove this space from consideration as soon as possible.
